

Third Report on Short-term Mission Trip (12-19 November 2005)

Monday Clinic

14 November

We started first day medical and dental clinic at our Thoed Thai Tai church in Thoed Thai village. This church is the first Shan (Tai) church to be dedicated in 2003 in notorious Golden Triangle.

People from other villages came to seek for medical and dental services as we offered free of charge. By the generosity of friends and churches from around the world we were able to buy medicines for patients. We had two medical teams and two dental teams working along side one another. The clinics began at about 9 AM and finished at about 5 PM. We had seen about 30 dental cases and about 50 medical cases. Most of them had minor problems only. The clinics ran very smoothly. Dr. Amy could even take extra job in teaching children ballet dancing during time off.
