Our church compound has been intruded and damaged by intruders like cows, buffalo and outsiders for years because we don't have fence to prevent such intrusion. Thank you for your financial gift to buy the concrete poles and barbed wire to erect the fence around our church compound. We did it ourselves to save labor cost. Our properties are now more secure.



A medical doctor from Japan, Dr. Tagami, has donated a truck to our Shan Missions four years ago. It's a great help for our mission trip and ferrying children from villages to the church and from church to villages. It's very dangerous to allow more than ten children to stand in the trunk without protection. We have put up a side bar to the trunk to prevent children from falling off from the truck when traveling. Thanks for your financial gift for this side bar.



Water was a big problem for us. We don't have water supply system from government. We need to dig our own well in our own compound. We have three wells but only one is useful. We have one old water storage tank but it is not high enough to give us water into the church building and evangelist's home. We have to carry the water with baskets by our own hands every time we need water. Last week we have built a tower and put up two water tanks to store the water from the well. **It is high enough to give us water to the building through the pipes. It saves us time and energy and makes life easier.**
